Wanted Suspect for Attempted Murder Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

April 6, 2021

San Diego County Crime Stoppers along with investigators from the San Diego County Fugitive Task Force are asking for the public's assistance in locating Christopher Templo Marquez.

On April 5th, 2021, at about 2:45 a.m., National City Police Department Officers conducted a high-risk vehicle stop on a stolen vehicle at the Jack in the Box located at 700 Roosevelt Avenue, in National City. During the vehicle stop, Christopher Marquez fled from the vehicle and shot at officers. Officers returned fire and after an extensive search, Marquez was not located. No officers were injured during the incident.

Additionally, on March 15th, 2021 at about 8:30 p.m., bail bond agents attempted to arrest Marquez for two outstanding felony warrants in the driveway of a home located at 600 East J Street in Chula Vista. During the contact, Marquez fired a handgun multiple times and struck one of the bail bond agents.

Marquez has prior convictions for robbery, 2nd degree burglary, auto theft, receiving stolen property and narcotic related offenses. Marquez is known to frequent the South Bay area. He should be considered armed and dangerous.

Description of Christopher Templo Marquez:

Marquez is described as a Filipino male, 36-years-old, 5'8" tall and weighing 190 pounds. He has brown hair and brown eyes. He has a tattoo on the right side of his face and on the top of his chest.
