## Unknown Suspect Wanted for Home Invasion Robbery and Assault in Oceanside

# SOLVED

**San Diego County Crime Stoppers**, along with investigators from the Oceanside Police Department's Crimes of Violence Unit, are asking for the public's help in locating the suspect wanted in connection with a home invasion robbery and assault.

On May 9, 2018, at about 5:30 p.m., Oceanside Police Officers responded to a report of a battery in the 500 block of Monterey Drive in Oceanside. Officers found the victim, a 64-year-old female, seriously battered and bloody. She reported that an unknown male attacked her in her bedroom. The victim sustained life-threatening injuries and is currently recovering in the hospital. Through the investigation, the male pictured below was identified as the suspect in this case.

**Suspect Description:** The suspect is described as a Black male, about 30 to 35-years-old, standing 5'9" tall, and weighing about 160 lbs. He has a shaved head, goatee, mustache, and possibly pierced ears. He was last seen riding a red bike.
