## Suspect Wanted for Felony Hit and Run

## Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

February 25, 2022

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Traffic Division are asking for the public's help in identifying and locating the vehicle and driver that fled the scene of a traffic collision resulting in the serious injury of a 25-year-old victim in the Paradise Hills area of San Diego.

On February 17, 2022, at about 2:50 a.m., a 25-year-old male was located laying in the roadway at 1900 Oriskany Road. The male had life threatening injuries and is believed to have been hit by a vehicle. The driver did not stop to check on the victim or call for help.
