Death Investigation Assistance

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

September 22, 2023

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Traffic Division are asking for the public's help with an incident that left a male deceased in the Otay Mesa West area of San Diego.

On Wednesday, September 6, 2023, at about 8:51 p.m., citizens called 911 to report finding a male down in the roadway at the intersection of Del Sol Boulevard and Beyer Way. Police and Fire personnel responded and discovered the male was suffering from a serious head injury. The male was not able to speak and there were no witnesses at the scene to indicate what happened to the male before he was found.

The male was transported to the hospital where he died on September 17, 2023, as a result of his injuries.

At this time, it is unknown how the male sustained the head injury.

The male was Hispanic, 42-years-old, about 5' 8" tall, 150 lbs., brown hair, and unshaven. He was wearing a black shirt, black sweatpants and was known to frequent the area.
