Who Killed Arthur Jordan?

\$1,000 Reward Offered

September 26, 2023

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Homicide Unit are asking for the public's help in identifying and locating the suspect(s) responsible for the murder of 28-year-old Arthur Jordan.

On Wednesday, July 19, 2018, at around 12:30 a.m., Arthur Jordan was a passenger sitting inside a vehicle at 3000 Martin Avenue, in San Diego. An unknown dark sedan style vehicle drove by, and the occupant(s) fired numerous rounds into the victim's vehicle. Arthur's friends escaped the attack by quickly driving out of the area. They called 9-1-1 while attempting to drive Arthur to the hospital. Officers located Arthur and the victim's vehicle at Park Boulevard and El Cajon Boulevard and rendered medical aid. Jordan was transported to a local hospital where he later succumbed to his injuries.

Despite an exhaustive follow-up investigation, including numerous witness interviews and forensic analysis of evidence, the murder investigation of Arthur Jordan went cold. Investigators and the victim's family are asking that anyone with information regarding this case to contact the San Diego Police Department Homicide Unit or Crime Stoppers.
