Suspect Wanted for Fatal Hit and Run

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

November 28, 2023

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Traffic Division are asking for the public's help in identifying and locating the vehicle and driver that fled the scene of a traffic collision leaving a male pedestrian with fatal injuries in the North Park area of San Diego.

On Tuesday, November 21, 2023, at about 7:15 p.m., a 42-year-old male pedestrian was hit by an unknown vehicle as he walked across Utah Street just south of Polk Avenue. The male pedestrian was seriously injured and died six days later. The involved vehicle fled the scene southbound on Utah Street.

Parts left at the scene had markings indicating they came from a 2017-2022 Hyundai Ioniq. Detectives are asking the public for any information regarding the identification of the suspect or the suspect's vehicle.

Vehicle Description:

Based on parts left at the scene, the suspect's vehicle is possibly an unknown color 2017-2022 Hyundai Ioniq with a missing trim piece between the driver's "A" pillar and the driver's side mirror as shown in the attached photo. There should also be damage to the driver's side front headlight and possibly dents and a cracked windshield on the driver's side of the vehicle.
