Suspect Wanted for Felony Hit and Run

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Traffic Division are asking for the public's help in identifying and locating the vehicle and driver that fled the scene of a serious injury traffic collision which occurred in the Del Mar Heights area of San Diego.

On October 16, 2021, at about 11:35 p.m., a 64-year-old male pedestrian was crossing 3200 Del Mar Heights Road, when he was struck by a vehicle traveling westbound. The driver did not stop to check on the victim or call for help and fled the scene immediately.

The victim sustained serious injuries and was transported to a local hospital for medical treatment.

Suspect's Vehicle Info:

The suspect's vehicle is described as a blue 2008-2009 Honda Accord with damage to the passenger side mirror.
